Burlap Wrapped Mum

Materials:

6 in mum
6 in saucer
18 in x 18 in square of burlap
Raffia
20 gauge florist wire
Hot glue gun
Glue stick
Accents of your choice like picks, bows, etc.

- 1. Pick a 6 in mum in your favorite color.
- 2. Cut a piece of burlap 18in x 18 in.
- 3. Place a 6 in saucer under the pot to catch water and to protect your table or other surface.
- 4. Center pot and saucer on burlap.
- 5. Fold up the four corners securing the corners with a 4 in piece of florist wire bent in a "U" shape. Use a heavy 20 gauge wire.
- 6. Use a glue gun to dab on dots of glue around burlap where you want to secure the raffia. Take 4 or more pieces of raffia and wrap around glued area on burlap. Be careful because the glue should be hot. Tie a bow with ends of raffia and secure bow with a dab of hot glue.
- 7. Add accents such as fall picks, silk leaves, or a fabric bow.
- 8. Check an indoor mum 2-3 times a week for watering. Water when dry to the touch I in into the soil.
- 9. An outdoor mum should be checked for water daily.
- 10. Remember, mums don't like wet feet. If water collects in the saucer, gently tilt the mum over and drain water immediately.
