- 2 3.8 cu. ft. Peat Moss
- 2 4 cu. ft. Perlite
- 12 lbs. 5-10-5 Garden Fertilizer
- 2 Scoops Premium Mulch

Butterfly Garden Alternative Selections

- **B** Sidalcea 'Party Girl' Summer flowering perennial with hollyhock-like blooms. Likes full sun and grows 18 to 24 inches tall. Foliage is lobed and divided. Nice pink flowers.
- **C** Joe Pye Weed Tall showy perennial prefers moist soil. Large 8 to 12 inch leaves give off a vanilla scent when crushed. Purple or white flowers in 12 to 18 inch clusters, in fall.
- **D** Veronica 'Sunny Border Blue' Remarkable for the rich, deep violet blue spiked flowers and its emerald green, beautifully textured foliage. Compact and trouble-free. Blooms freely from early summer to frost.
- **F Gay Feather -** Purple or white flowres open from top of each stiffly erect spike. Summer bloomer is a useful accent plant for borders.
- **G** Daylily Adaptable, low-maintenance lily-like garden plants grow in a wide range of colors and heights. Long leaves form big clumps.
- H Purple Cone Flower Flowers have orange-brown raised centers and purple, rose, or white ray petals, slightly relaxed. Tolerates heat, drought, and wind. Height 24 to 36 inches tall.
- I Globe Thistle Striking globular dark blue flower heads in summer. Tolerates drought. Good accent for middle or back of border. Useful in dried arrangements.
- **K Coreopsis 'Early Sunrise' -** Golden yellow flowers are 2 inches across. Starts blooming early and continues throughout the season. Grows to 20 inches tall.
- L Catmint Spreading aromatic herb with gray-green leaves topped with spikes of dark blue-purple blooms in late spring. Nice edger in rock gardens, or as a groundcover.
- M Basket-of-Gold Brilliant yellow flowers in tight clusters, from early spring to early summer. Foliage gray-green mounding 6 to 12 inches.
- **N** Blanket Flower 'Goblin' Dwarf form with yellow-tipped red daisy flowers. Height 9 to 12 inches. Tolerates heat and drought and average to poor soil.
- O Lavender 'Hidcote' Bushy perennial with fragrant foliage and flowers. Semievergreen gray foliage topped by spikes of deep blue flowers in summer. Grows 12 inches high.
- **P** Sea Pink Tufts of blue-green narrow leaves form spreading clumps that mound to 6 to 12 inches. Flowers in summer in masses of ball-shaped clusters of pink, mauve-red, lilac, or white blossoms which rise above foliage.
